



## TEMPORARY BOARDING

If you find the thought of committing to a dog for a year just too much, but want to have a dog to love occasionally, our temporary boarding program could be for you. This program is where our dogs-in-training would stay in the homes of our temporary boarders overnight and during weekends. Occasionally, a dog may need to be placed for a longer period of time to cover illness and/or holidays.

This temporary boarding program allows our dogs to experience a wide variety of home situations and takes them out of the kennel environment while in training with their puppy raiser or during advanced training.

We are looking for people who:

- ◆ Live locally, ideally within 30 minutes of Brigadoon Youth & Service Dog Programs location, and can collect and return the dog to us (during our open hours, or times pre-arranged).
- ◆ Have a fully enclosed yard or area the dog can run safely.
- ◆ Will let the dog be inside the house, not left out in the yard.
- ◆ Will not leave the dog for longer than a maximum of four hours.
- ◆ Have regular contact with children, dogs, cats, etc.
- ◆ Are prepared to spend time each day walking the dog nicely on the lead.
- ◆ If you have children, the children are ideally over 3 years of age. A temporary boarder would still be considered with younger children.

Temporary boarding will not cost you anything. We, or the puppy raiser will provide the food.

**Brigadoon only requires a small amount of temporary boarders at any time and preference will be given to applications that can offer boarding during the day and collect from Brigadoon in Bellingham.**
